- Visual Supports: Use picture schedules and social stories to assist understanding.
- **Communication Aids:** Augmentative communication tools, such as PECS or speech apps, can help nonverbal children express themselves.
- **Therapies:** Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA), Speech Therapy, and Occupational Therapy can improve skills.
